

Cookie Policy Historisch Museum Den Briel

This website is operated by Historisch Museum Den Briel, a department of the municipality Brielle (hereafter referred to as "Historisch Museum Den Briel" or "we"). Our website uses cookies. A cookie is a small text file which will be saved on your computer or mobile device when you visit that website. This way, the website remembers the pages that you visited and preferences (such as language and font size), so you do not need to re-enter these each time you visit the website.

Cookies can be both 'permanent' (persistent) and 'temporary' (session) cookies. A permanent cookie consists of text file sent by a web server to a web browser that will be stored by the browser and remains in effect until the set expiration date of the cookie (unless they are removed before that date by). A temporary cookie, on the other hand, will disappear at the end of the user session, when the browser is closed.

This Cookie Statement explains which cookies we use, for what purposes and what options you have to manage the cookies.

1. The cookies we use and the purposes

The cookies used by Historisch Museum Den Briel can be divided into two types: *Functional cookies* - These are the cookies that are indispensable for the proper functioning of our website.

Other types of cookies - In addition, Historisch Museum Den Briel uses cookies to see if this is your first visit to the website outside the home page (to display the logo and to have it fade out). Historisch Museum Den Briel also uses cookies to keep track of web statistics by using Google Analytics. We also use social media functionality so pages can be easily shared.

2. Managing your cookies

If you do not want to have cookies placed on your computer or mobile device, you can adjust the settings of your browser to allow to receive a warning before certain cookies are stored. You can also adjust the settings to have your browser refuse certain cookies. Please take into account that certain parts of the website will not function (optimally) when you block cookies. How you can disable cookies depends on your browser and device. If necessary, enable the help function of the browser or click on one of the links below to go directly to the manual of your browser:
